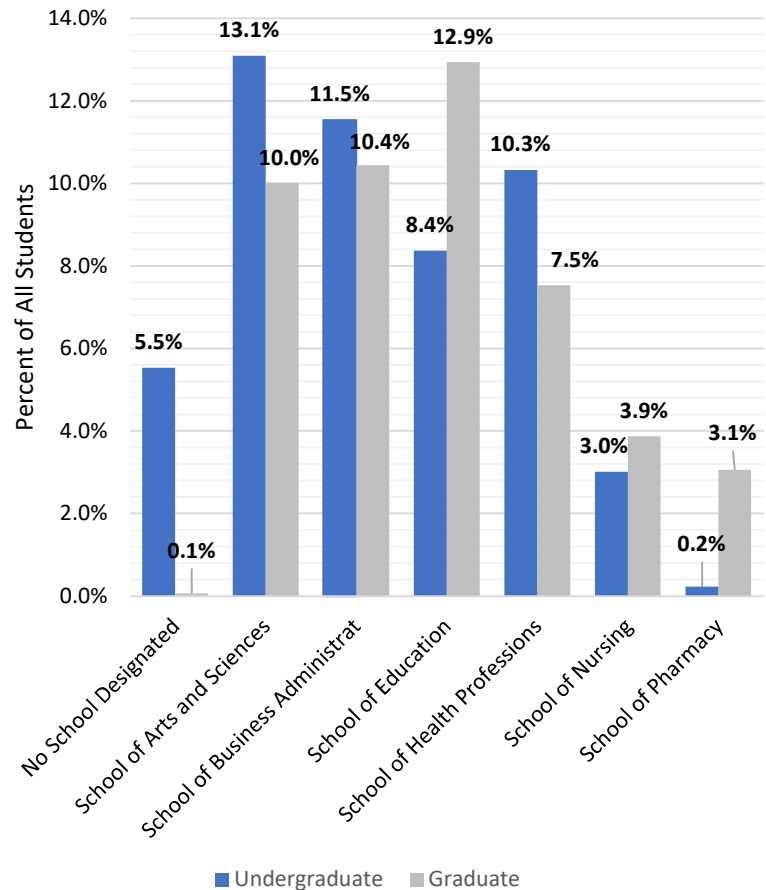
Fall 2025 Census Enrollment: 4,577

- **79.59 %** of Traditional Full Time New Freshmen Undergraduates in Fall 2023 (202410) returned for their Sophomore Year in Fall 2024 (202510)
- **69.3%** of Traditional Undergraduate students graduated within 6 years, Fall 2018 Cohort (National Average 64%)

What our 2024-2025 Graduates are saying according to our Survey of Graduates (1,564 Graduates surveyed; 21% response rate):

- **98%** of our graduates agreed that they are better prepared to serve and lead by putting the needs of others first.
- **96%** agreed that their academic program helped them to develop skills to be successful (critical thinking, communication, use of technology).
- **91%** agreed that they grew in Christian faith during their time at Concordia.
